Notes:

- Color guard does not salute or participate in the pledge. Their ceremony is their salute.
- Both Class A and Class B uniforms are considered uniforms. They salute instead of using the "civilian" hand-over-heart.
- The T25 hat is a part of the troop uniform. It remains worn during flag ceremonies if you are otherwise in full Class A or B uniform. Exception: A Scout is Reverent - hats are not worn in a house of worship or during religious ceremonies.
